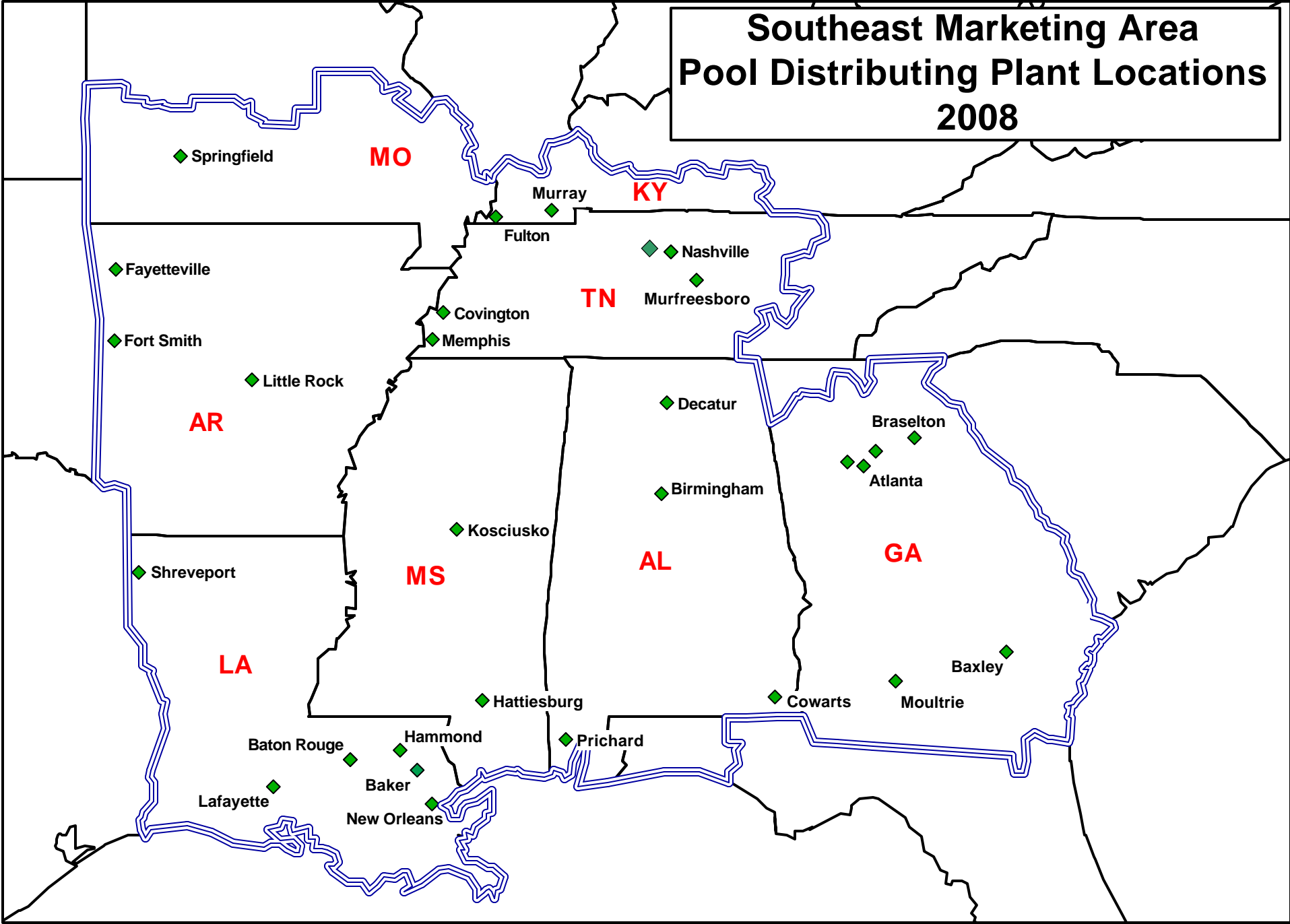

Part 1000 states that the Market Administrator shall "Prepare and disseminate publicly for the benefit of producers, handlers, and consumers such statistics and other information concerning operation of the order and facts relevant to the provisions thereof (or proposed provisions) as do not reveal confidential information."

# Southeast Marketing Area Pool Distributing Plant Locations 2008



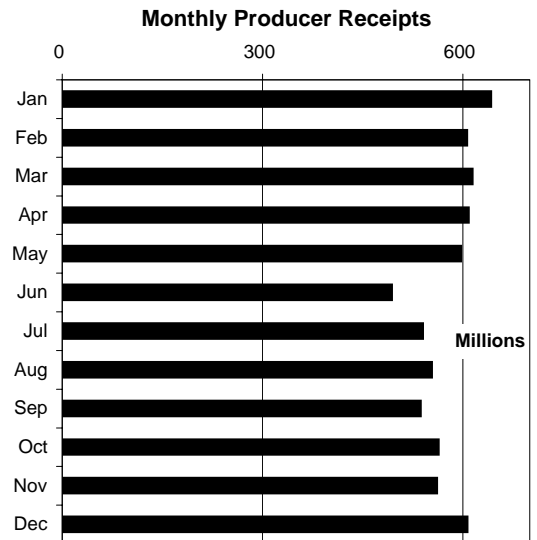

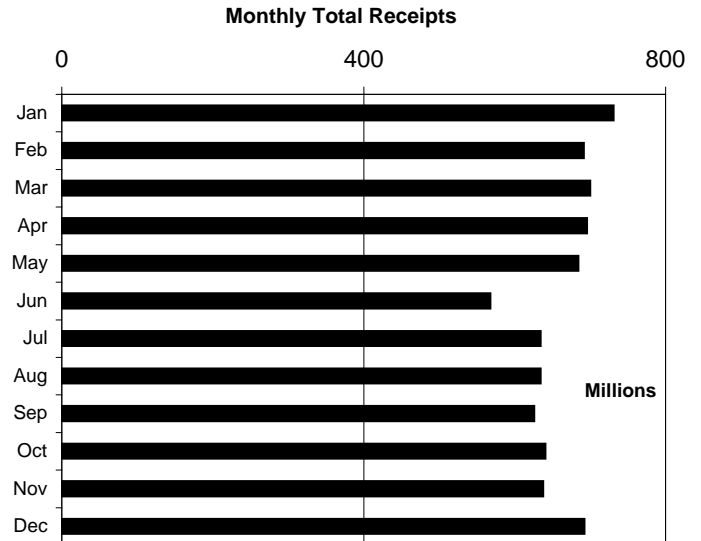

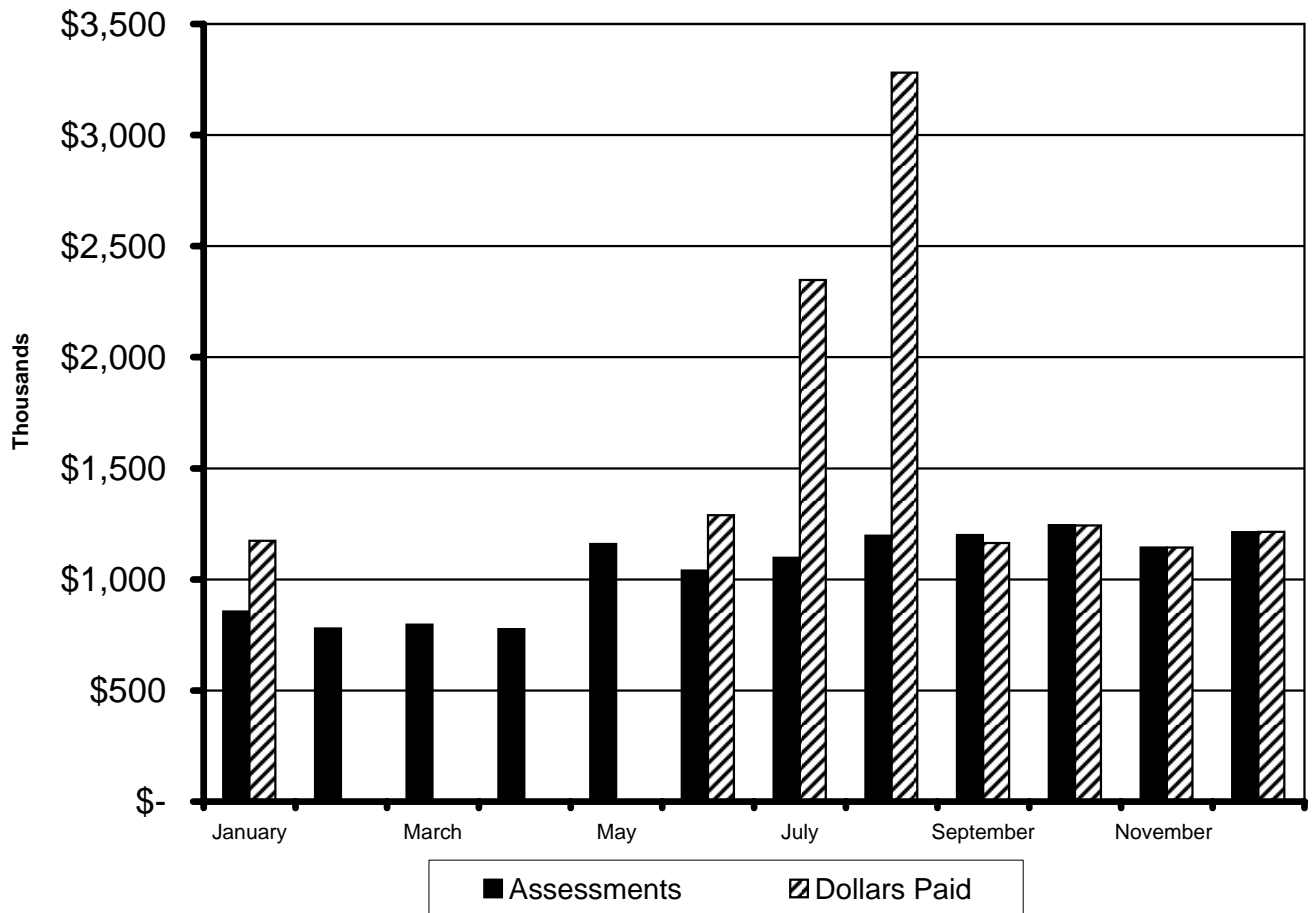
