2/ The 20-cent per hundredweight processor assessment is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7CFR§1160.101 et seq.) imposed on any person who processes and markets commercially more than 3 million pounds of packaged fluid milk products on a monthly basis. Deliveries to consumer residences are excluded. Effective February 29, 2016, processors of certified "organic" and "100 percent organic" fluid milk products may apply for an organic assessment exemption for those products.

3/ The Transportation Credit Balancing Fund is a marketwide assessment on Federal Order 7 pursuant to §1007.81 of the order. The per hundredweight assessment is applied to the total pounds of Class I producer milk.

4/ The Distributing Plant Delivery Credit Fund is a marketwide assessment on Federal Order 6 and Federal Order 7 pursuant to § 1006.84 and §1007.84 of the orders. The per hundredweight assessment is applied to the total pounds of Class I producer milk.

5/ Class I Extended Shelf Life (ESL) Adjustment for ESL products is equal to the average of the advanced Class III and Class IV skim pricing factors less the higher of the advanced Class III and Class IV skim pricing factors plus a 24-month rolling average adjuster with a 12-month lag.
